HEALTH GUARANTEE TERMS

1. VETERINARY CARE

All Triple P Babies Pomeranian puppies receive a veterinary exam and age-appropriate vaccinations prior to going home.

Important Note:

As a breeder, I am not a licensed veterinarian. I am highly knowledgeable and experienced in the care of Pomeranians and available to offer advice. However, all medical decisions should be made in consultation

with your licensed veterinarian.

I do not recommend the leptospirosis (lepto) vaccine for Pomeranians. It has been known to cause reactions in small dogs. While the vaccine has reportedly improved, I remain cautious and encourage you to be too. Your vet may advise differently depending on your lifestyle and area, so make an informed decision together.

You agree to maintain routine veterinary care including annual wellness checkups and an up-to-date vaccine schedule.

2. INITIAL HEALTH GUARANTEE

This puppy is guaranteed to be in good health at the time of pick-up or delivery. Buyer has 72 hours from receiving the puppy to have them examined by a licensed veterinarian.

If a life-threatening congenital defect is found, buyer must notify breeder immediately with written documentation from the vet.

I reserve the right to have the dog examined by my veterinarian to confirm the diagnosis before a replacement is offered.

3. ONE-YEAR CONGENITAL GUARANTEE

Triple P Babies guarantees this puppy free of life-threatening congenital defects for one year from birth. Covered conditions are serious genetic issues involving major organs (e.g., heart, eyes) deemed untreatable or fatal by a veterinarian.

If confirmed, buyer may receive a replacement puppy of equal value when one is available.

No cash refunds.

4. RETURN POLICY

If at any point the buyer cannot keep the puppy or dog, it must be returned to the breeder.

Buyer may not rehome, sell, or place the dog without written consent from the breeder.

This dog is never to be surrendered to a shelter, pound, or rescue. Legal action may be taken if this condition is violated.

5. CONDITIONS NOT COVERED

This health guarantee does not cover:

- Luxating patellas
- Hypoglycemia
- Internal or external parasites
- Collapsed trachea (commonly caused by trauma, collars, or improper grooming)
- Cosmetic flaws
- Vaccine or medication reactions
- Any condition that is non-life-threatening or treatable

6. PUBLIC EXPOSURE

Buyer agrees to keep the puppy out of public places (parks, pet stores, etc.) until the full vaccine series is completed.

7. LEGAL JURISDICTION

In the event of a legal dispute, both parties agree that jurisdiction shall be in the State of Georgia, in Bulloch County, where the seller resides.
